

the first ever proposal for permanent nuclear reactor waste disposal in Canada. A decision to license the facility would <u>contradict UNDRIP</u>, the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples, and <u>fail to meet international safety standards</u> for radioactive waste
